

Say **NO** to *(Expired, Unused, Unwanted) Drugs*

Do you know how long has it been since you've cleaned out your medicine cabinet? Chances are, your cabinet is full of prescribed medications that are no longer needed and out of date.

In addition to offering Drug Take Back events throughout the year, the Christiansburg Police Department will now accept unwanted, unused and expired prescription drugs year round.

Through a donation from CVS, a drop off box has been installed in the main lobby of the Christiansburg Police Department, 10 East Main Street.

You may drop off your unwanted prescriptions Monday through Friday between 8 a.m. and 12 p.m., no questions asked.

Disposing of medications properly can help prevent poisoning of children and pets; deter misuse by teenagers and adults; avoid health problems from accidentally taking the wrong medicine; too much of the same medicine; or a medicine that is too old to work well. By using the drug take back box, you also help keep medicines from entering streams and rivers when poured down the drain or flushed down the toilet.

We **cannot** accept any of the following:

- Thermometers
- Hydrogen peroxide
- Needles or other sharps
- Inhalers
- Medicines from businesses or clinics
- Ointments, lotions, liquids
